Matters Arising:

<u>10 Planning Applications</u> The Appeal of Old Bakehouse, 30 Main Street, Kilby, discussions are still being made with Blaby District Council.

Outline Planning Application for 150 New David Wilson Properties on Kilby Road , Fleckney, being proposed, Mr Andy Collins has submitted comments to Harborough District Council.

The application for conversion of two barns and new house at Limes Farm, Main Street, Kilby, Mr Collins has submitted comments to Blaby District Council, also it was agreed additional comments will be submitted to Blaby District Council regarding the Flood Risks to the property.

- <u>11 Defibrillator</u> It was agreed that Mr Jones and Mr Tunnicliffe would paint the telephone box inside and out, put up a Defibrillator sign in the telephone box, as this item remains outstanding.
- 12 Play Park Mr Tunnicliffe and Mr Kilsby agreed they would take down the climbing frame down, and dispose of it. It was agreed that the Clerk would obtain three quotations to replace the climbing frame and contact Blaby District Council regarding the S106 Grant Application process, to assist with the purchase of a replacement climbing frame.
- <u>13 Transparency Code Grant</u> Leicestershire and Rutland Associations council have new grant money available in 2016 to cover additional staff costs of implementation of the Transparency code. It was agreed that the Clerk would apply for a new grant for 2016/17.
- <u>14 Grass Cutting</u> The grass cutting with EMH (Sharpe's) remains an issue at the side of number 9 Wistow Road, also the number of cuts remain infrequent. The clerk is to Contact EMH is follow up this issue again.
- 15 <u>Weight Restriction Signs</u> Councillor Jennings has agreed to contact County Highways regarding a missing weight restriction sign just inside Spinney Road, plus cutting back foliage from the existing weight restriction sign.
