

What are the options and what will it cost?


| Number of people in household | Standard capacity bin(s) (free of charge) | Maximum capacity bin(s) (charges apply)* |
|-------------------------------------|---|--|
| Up to three people | Medium 140ltr | Large 240ltr |
| 4-6 | Large 240ltr | Large 240ltr and Medium 140ltr |
| 7+ | Large 240ltr and Medium 140ltr | 2x Large 240ltr bins |

*Each bin will cost £17.50 regardless of the type and size of bin. The Council has purchased a number of bins in bulk to help keep bin costs as low as possible. The payment covers the cost of buying and delivering the bin including any associated administrative costs in doing so.

If you think you'll need bins please submit your request **before midnight on Sunday 6**th **May** to have the best chance of delivery before the expected start date on 2nd July 2018.



What's changing and why?

The Council will be changing from weekly collections to alternate weekly collections for refuse and recycling.

Alternate weekly collections are expected to begin on 2^{nd} July 2018. Look out for a notice on your bin in June confirming the final details.

The change is necessary due to external funding for the service of £745,000 being withdrawn, and savings having to be made.


What will this mean?

Your refuse and recycling collections will change to alternate weekly, with refuse collected one week and recycling collected on the other week.

If you feel you need larger or additional bins you will be able to order them for delivery before the start of alternate weekly collections or at any time after the start date.

Ordering larger or additional bins after 2nd July

You might decide to keep the bins you have to see how you get on. If you do this but later decide you want larger or additional bins, you will still be able to order them on the website or over the phone.



How will the exchange of bins work?

If you are requesting a larger bin (this doesn't apply to additional bins), you will need to return your existing bin. This will be explained to you when you submit your request via www.blaby.gov.uk/waste2018.

What about garden waste?

There is no change to the garden waste service.
